Building Committee:

those involved in assessing the needs and developing plans for facilities expansion or remodel.

Cemetery Committee:

those involved in overseeing the maintenance of St. Luke's cemetery.

Congregational Officers & Boards:

those who serve in elected positions

Strategic Focus Groups:

those who gather to brainstorm and research when topics arise

CARE-GIVING:

Card Ministry:

those who send out caring notes and cards to others.

those who deliver CD's of the worship services to those who are unable to attend.

Telecare Ministry:

those who receive training and extend friendship by means of phone calls on a continuing basis.

Visitation Ministry:

those who visit the homebound and hospitalized to offer support and prayer.

Bible Study:

those interested in leading, assisting, or participating in study groups on Sundays or during the week.

Confirmation Mentors:

those who assist with activities associated with the confirmation students.

Day School Helpers:

volunteers who help in the classroom, library, kitchen, or school office during the school year.

Sunday School:

volunteers for teachers, substitute teachers and helper positions.

Time for Two:

working with 2 year-olds and parents in an interactive classroom setting.

Tutoring:

volunteers to help students improve their skills.
